



Ecological Teaching and Learning (ETL) Scholarship for students beginning in summer 2012

What is the ETL Scholarship?

The Graduate School of Arts & Social Sciences, Ecological Teaching and Learning Scholarship is for newly-enrolling students in the ETL Program. Scholarship amounts for the 2012 – 2013 academic year range from \$1000 - \$2500 and are non-renewable.

Scholarship Statement

The Graduate School of Arts & Social Sciences is dedicated to the fundamental principle that the role of higher education is to develop and nurture a creative, civil, and life-sustaining society. In support of this mission, our programs seek to recruit, encourage, and support students who enrich our learning communities with their community or volunteer experiences, professional experiences, life experiences, strong academic achievement, leadership qualities, artistic abilities, and potential to be student ambassadors and later alumni ambassadors. The Scholarship Committee encourages the application of candidates who embody any number of the qualities mentioned above. The Committee and the Graduate School of Arts & Social Sciences encourage the application of all candidates without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, national or ethnic origin, sexual orientation, mental or physical disability or veteran status in the administration of its education policies and scholarship.

Scholarship Criteria:

An applicant to the Scholarship should have a strong academic background, demonstrated leadership skills, and a commitment to the field of education for sustainability, environmental leadership, and/or environmental education.

- Student must be accepted to one of the ETL cohorts beginning summer 2012.
- Student must have a minimum GPA of a 3.0 in a previous degree program.
- Student must submit a complete scholarship application by March 1, 2012.

Application Requirements:

Student must have a complete admissions application on file or be accepted to the ETL Master's Degree Program beginning in the summer 2012. Students must submit the scholarship application, essay, and resume by March 1, 2012.
