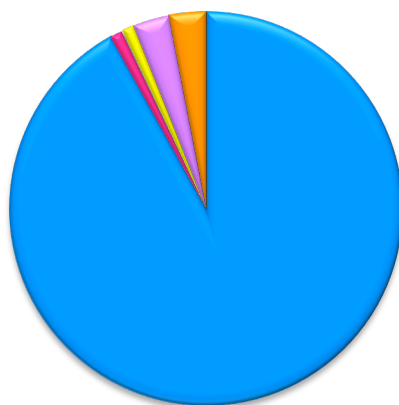
2015 Graduates - On Campus Programs

This is a summary of the survey of the 2015 graduates of the on-campus programs in the Graduate School of Education. The survey was sent to 441 graduates 6 months after graduation, and 276 responded for a response rate of 63%.

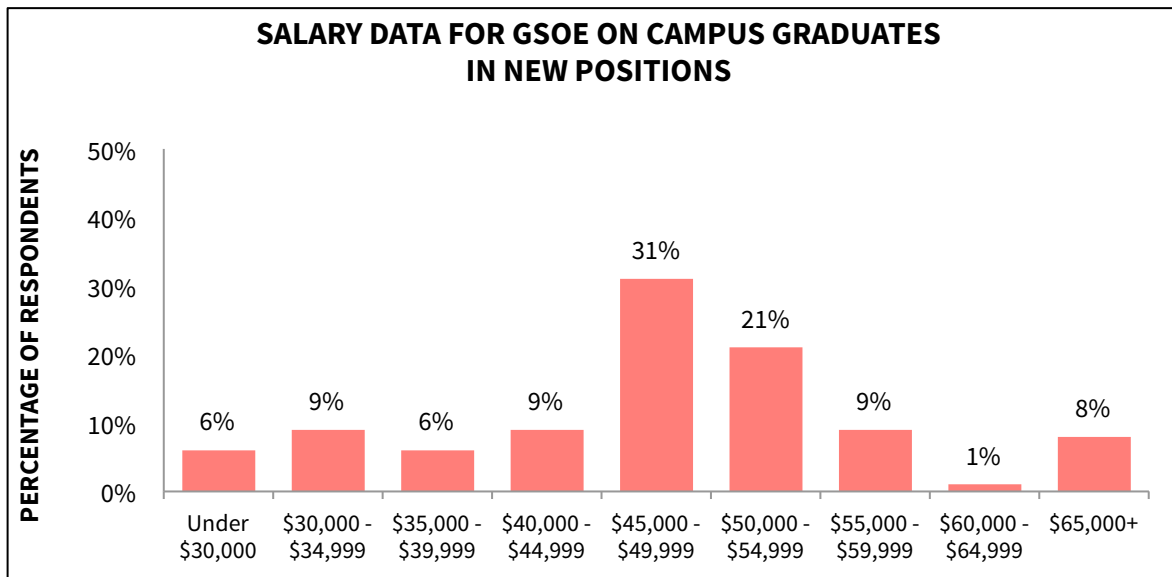
Highlights:

- 97% of those available for employment are employed (Employment Rate).
- 99% of those employed reported that their work is related to their career goals.
- 95% of those employed are working full time.
