The MA DESE administers New Teacher Employer Survey to ask recent employers to evaluate Lesley graduates. The target population for this survey are principals who have employed a recent graduate (within one year of graduation). We track the results for this survey question annually, but The MA DESE didn't administer the cohort of 2019-2020 due to the Covid related circumstances but will administer the cohort of 2020-2021 after this report is due. Instead, we present the latest survey results for Supervising Practitioners and the trend of employment rates as a proxy measure of ongoing satisfaction of employers for Lesley education programs' graduates.
